**C**olin Challis was born in Lowestoft and is a talented bird painter. His paintings were spotted by the founder of Lowestoft Porcelain who asked him to translate them into illustrations on fine bone china pieces.

The Sparrow beak creamer jug, a traditional Lowestoft Porcelain shape, has been used to feature mainly British birds. These have been hand painted as a range of limited edition pieces.

The other items shown are two examples of Colin's recent work which were painted as a single commissioned piece.

The Barn Owl/Barn Tea-Caddy shown was inspired by the continual loss of barns as wildlife habitats. It is hoped that recognition can be given to organisations such as the Suffolk Ornithology Group who are erecting barn owl nest boxes to ensure the preservation of such a wonderful bird.
